



Annual Jay A. Sher, M.D. Endocrinology and Metabolism Symposium

Jay Allan Sher, M.D., completed his Fellowship in Endocrinology at the University of Miami Medical School. He completed his residency and internship in Internal Medicine at Nassau County Medical Center and his medical degree from the State University of New York – Downstate Medical School (SUNY-Downstate). Upon completing his Fellowship, Dr. Sher joined the staff of Woodhull Medical Center where he served as Co-Director of the Division of Endocrinology. During this time, Dr. Sher held the rank of Clinical Assistant Professor of Medicine at SUNY-Downstate as well as various leadership positions at Woodhull Medical Center, where he ultimately served as President of Medical Staff.

Dr. Sher became the Director of Diabetes in 1988 and assumed the role of Section Chief in 1999 at Jersey Shore University Medical Center. He was a core clinical faculty member and Associate

Program Director in the Internal Medicine Residency Program. Since 2005, he served as the Site Program Director for the Endocrinology Fellowship Program sponsored by Rutgers Robert Wood Johnson Medical School where he also was the Clinical Associate Professor of Medicine. In addition, Dr. Sher held key leadership positions related to quality and efficiency at both the hospital and system level. At Jersey Shore University Medical Center, he was the chair of the Pharmacy and Therapeutics Committee and co-chaired the Drug Utilization Committee and was a member of the Computer Committee and the Department's Performance Improvement/Peer Review Committee. Dr. Sher was also the chair of the Meridian Health Formulary Committee and served on the Information Technology Steering Committee and the Clinical Excellence Committee. In 2014, Dr. Sher played a key role in the hospital's successful application for recognition for Diabetes Excellence by the Joint Commission, making Jersey Shore University Medical Center one of only three hospitals in the state and fewer than 50 nationwide to have achieved this award.

Dr. Sher was triple board certified in Internal Medicine, Endocrinology and Medical Consultants. He had been recognized by his peers as a Top Doc in New Jersey Monthly Magazine. He was a member of the American Diabetes Association and the American Academy of Clinical Endocrinologists as well as a Fellow of the American College of Endocrinology and the American College of Physicians. In recognition of his clinical excellence and medical leadership and his devotion to his patients, our department and our medical center, Dr. Sher received the 2014 Department of Medicine Lifetime Achievement Award.

Jay passed away on January 23, 2015. His legacy will endure through the clinical excellence he inspired, the Diabetes program that he established and the family of which he was so proud; his wife Elaine and their four children: Heather, Erin, Samantha, and Alex.
